



## School Uniform

We expect children to dress in an appropriate manner for school. The recognised Rydon School uniform is detailed below:

Boys	Girls
White Shirt	White Blouse
Grey/Black Trousers	Grey Skirt/Pinafore/Trousers

For KS1 children we recommend the following to aid dressing: Short Sleeved Shirts Elasticated School Tie Velcro or Buckle Plain Shoes	<u>In warmer weather</u> Blue and White stripe or check dresses White or Maroon Cardigan/Jumper <u>In colder weather</u> Black trousers

Please note that fashionable items such as trainers, t-shirts and jeans are not allowed to be worn in school. They may be worn during such activities as field expeditions or school residential but not on more normal outside visits such as museums or theatres.

Children should not wear items of jewellery at school. The exception to this rule is where a child has had ears pierced and needs to wear a "sleeper". In such cases these must, for safety reasons, be of a stud type, and not rings.

Long hair on both girls and boys should be tied back neatly. Please ensure also that hair bands, clips etc are of an appropriate simple type and not too ornate or fashionable.

### PE Kit

#### Foundation and KS1

Children will usually do outside PE (running, skipping, throwing, catching, kicking etc activities) in their normal school clothes and shoes. School shoes should therefore be fit for this purpose. Open-toed sandals and shoes with a heel are considered inappropriate. In the summer term, in the lead up to sports day, children will wear PE kit and will require footwear suitable for running, jumping etc.



For indoor PE sessions (gymnastic and dance activities), the children will need PE kit consisting of navy or black shorts and white t-shirts or t-shirts in the colour of their house team. Indoor PE is always carried out in bare feet.

### **Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6)**

Children will do almost all PE in sports kit. They will also require trainers for all outside PE sessions (once a week). The sports kits consist of navy or black shorts and white t-shirts or t-shirts in the colour of their house team – sports kits will need to be in school on PE days. Indoor PE is carried out in bare feet. As part of physical activity, children will be required to take part in activities such as skipping and running in their school shoes. School shoes do therefore need to be fit for this purpose. Open-toed sandals and shoes with higher heels would be considered inappropriate.

During colder weather, it is acceptable for children to wear extra layers of clothing such as joggers and a sweater for outdoor games. There is no specific colour you need to buy. If a child represents the school, kit will be provided in the school colours.
